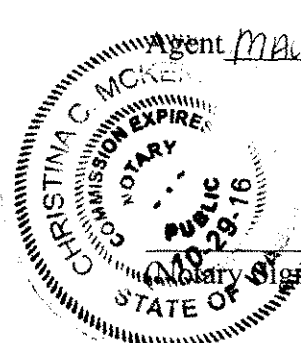

### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2013-0347**  
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the **23rd day of September, 2013, at 1:30 p.m.**, to consider adoption of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2013-0347, authorizing the sheriff's office to impound watercraft in order to protect persons and property; amending Ordinance 10278, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 46.08.010, Ordinance 5846, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C.46.08.040, Ordinance 10278, Section 6, and K.C.C. 46.08.060, Ordinance 10278, Section 7, and K.C.C. 46.08.070, Ordinance 10278, Section 9, and K.C.C. 46.08.080, Ordinance 10278, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 46.08.100, Ordinance 10278, Section 11, and K.C.C. 46.08.110, Ordinance 5846, Section 12, and K.C.C. 46.08.120 and adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 46.08.

#### SUMMARY

This Proposed Substitute Ordinance would place in King County Code provisions for impounding and redeeming boats and other watercraft. King County Sheriff's Office deputies can currently identify watercraft being operated by individuals under the influence, where it is unsafe to allow the operators to continue, but county code currently contains no provisions for impounding the boat in these situations. This Proposed Substitute Ordinance provides processes, similar to those for motor vehicles, for ensuring that a watercraft can be impounded when no person is immediately available to safely operate or moor the boat. The measure also provides processes for redeeming the impounded watercraft and for appealing the impoundment.

Additionally, this Proposed Substitute Ordinance makes technical changes to the county's existing code sections for impounding motor vehicles to update and clarify sections that have not been revised since 1992.
