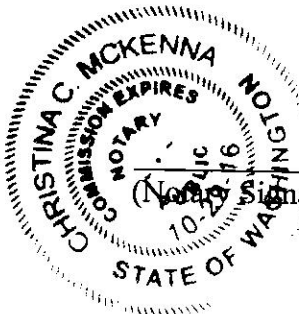

METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Proposed Ordinance 2012-0430

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on the 10th day of December, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance No. 2012-0430 relating to transportation concurrency, adopting a new concurrency map and updated travel shed boundaries map.

SUMMARY:

The concurrency map is a tool for ensuring that King County's transportation infrastructure is adequate to meet the needs of new development. The concurrency map identifies which travel sheds throughout unincorporated King County pass or fail the concurrency test, as measured by travel time standards applied to each travel shed. A proposed development must be in a passing travel shed as an initial step in the project development process. A revised travel shed boundaries map illustrates travel sheds used in concurrency testing and is updated to account for recent annexations. Proposed Ordinance 2012-0430 amends King County Code 14.70 by adopting a new transportation concurrency map and revised travel shed boundaries map. The concurrency map was generated by travel time data collected in spring 2012 and applied to travel speed standards in the King County Code. This map replaces the current transportation concurrency map adopted in February 2011. The travel shed boundaries map accounts for recent annexations and replaces the current map adopted in January 2012. This new maps will be reviewed and potentially approved by the King County Council.
