This landmark Reconciliation program will serve 500 (50/3) organizations and individuals. It is not nearly as broad as other programs, but very considerable "match ability" in making grants.

1. Full Tax Projections based on 1992 Projections (1992 Target Balance should be added to OCR unallocated funds - 1992 \$1.6 million, 2012 \$2.1 million)  
 2. 2011-12 assumes 3% per year increase in tax revenue (follows State forecasts for 2001)  
 3. Target Fund Balance in 1992 and 1993 reflect the difference between the actual or projected revenue and approved appropriation  
 4. Heritage Preservation (20%) and Arts (80%) are assumed to be funded from the 1992 program  
 5. Administration from 1992 to 2012 assumes 8.5% of the Cultural Programs and reflects the 1992 program  
 6. Heritage Preservation and Arts are assumed to be funded from the 1992 program  
 7. Administration from 1992 to 2012 is assumed to be funded from the 1992 program  
 8. Assumptions and estimates are based on the 1992 program  
 9. Numbers in Italics represent actual revenues and appropriations adopted
