1 A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'
2 pamphlet statements for the April 22, 2025, special election
3 regarding Ordinance 19884 providing for the submission to
4 the qualified electors of King County, at a special election
5 on April 22, 2025, a proposition to reauthorize an expired
6 regular property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation
7 contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive seven
8 year period beginning in 2026 at the rate of not more than
9 \$0.0275 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation,
10 with the 2026 levy amount being the base for computing
11 maximum allowable levy amounts under chapter 84.55
12 RCW for years two through seven (2027-2032), for the
13 purpose of funding the continued operation of the regional
14 automated fingerprint identification system, also known as
15 AFIS, which maintains expanded crime scene and arrest
16 identification technology and services for all local criminal
17 justice agencies in King County.

18 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
19 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for annual general
20 elections held in King County, and

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21 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that, for each measure from a
22 jurisdiction that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that
23 jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter
24 approval of the measure and whenever possible, a committee to prepare arguments
25 advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

26 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that the legislative authority shall
27 appoint individuals residing within the jurisdictional boundaries to the committees, and

28 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19884 provides for the submission to the qualified
29 electors of King County, at a special election on April 22, 2025, a proposition to
30 reauthorize an expired regular property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained
31 in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive seven year period beginning in 2026 at the rate
32 of not more than \$0.0275 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation, with the 2026
33 levy amount being the base for computing maximum allowable levy amounts under
34 chapter 84.55 RCW for years two through seven (2027-2032), for the purpose of funding
35 the continued operation of the regional automated fingerprint identification system, also
36 known as AFIS, which maintains expanded crime scene and arrest identification
37 technology and services for all local criminal justice agencies in King County;

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

39 Pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, the following individuals are appointed to serve on
40 the voters' pamphlet committees, with each committee to write a statement for or against
41 the proposed levy:

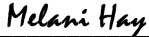
