- 5 implementing the Puget Sound emergency radio network project as described in
- 6 Ordinance 17993 and approved by the voters at the election held on April 28, 2015, are
- 7 executed, the executive shall transmit letters no less than quarterly that include the
- 8 anticipated date of execution for each of these Puget Sound emergency radio network
- 9 leases or licenses or extensions of a lease or license. The executive shall file the letters in
- 10 the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk of the council, who
- 11 shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the council
- 12 chief of staff and the lead staff for the budget and fiscal management committee, or its
- 13 successor."
