NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 26th day of February, 2018, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2018-0037, which would amend the King County Zoning Code to add a new use, "regional transit authority facility" and permit that new use within the low density urban residential zones. This use would be exempt from height and setback requirements.

The Council will review the subject legislation as recommended by the Council's Transportation, Economy and Environment (TrEE) committee. Councilmembers may offer amendments to that legislation for consideration by the Council. As a result, persons interested in any of the issues raised in the subject legislation should make their views known at the public hearing on February 26, 2018. Amendments that may be considered for adoption by the Council on February 26 or thereafter include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- Allowing the regional transit authority facility as a conditional use, rather than permitted outright;
- Modifying or removing the proposed total exemption on setback or height requirements;
- Requiring a development agreement approved by ordinance following a public hearing at the Council for these types of facilities;
- Any other proposed amendment that is within the scope of the information that has been available for public comment.
