### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

#### Ordinance 19040

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Wednesday, December 11, 2019, beginning at 9:30 AM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0433 (Ordinance 19040), an ordinance relating to the County's zoning code. The Council then adopted this Ordinance at that same meeting.

#### SUMMARY:

Ordinance 19040 amends the King County Zoning Code to allow private golf facilities to have overnight lodging, subject to specific development conditions.
