A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RENTON, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO TAKE THOSE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO PLACE PROPOSITION 1 BEFORE THE VOTERS, INCLUDING THE PREPARATION OF INFORMATION FOR THE VOTER'S PAMPHLET, FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 6, 2007, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY 1,475 ACRES OF CONTIGUOUS UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY WITHIN RENTON'S EAST RENTON PLATEAU POTENTIAL ANNEXATION AREA, ALSO KNOWN AS THE PRESERVE OUR PLATEAU ANNEXATION AREA (POPA).

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2006, the City of Renton passed Resolution No. 3829 supporting the annexation of contiguous unincorporated territory, referred to as the Preserve Our Plateau Annexation area, lying generally in the area bounded by the City of Renton corporate boundary and SE 128th Street west of 156th Avenue SE, and north of SE 138th Street and the Urban Growth Area boundary east of 154th Place SE/156th Avenue SE; and

WHEREAS, in that Resolution the City Council called for a special election to be held on February 6, 2007, pursuant to Chapter 29.13.020 RCW and Chapter 35A.14 RCW, to submit to the voters of the aforesaid territory the proposal for annexation; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to authorize the actions necessary to place Proposition 1 before the voters for the February 6, 2007, election;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENTON, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I The above findings are true and correct in all respects.

SECTION II The City Clerk is authorized and directed to take those actions necessary to place Proposition 1 before the voters on the February 6, 2007, election.
