37 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

38 SECTION 1. A. Sections 2 through 29 of this ordinance update fees currently
39 charged related to the department of local services, permitting division and road services
40 division, and the department of natural resources and parks.

41 B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.G.1.

42 SECTION 2. Ordinance 10662, Section 45, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.02.040
43 are hereby amended to read as follows:

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44 A. The director shall have the discretion to waive all or a portion of the fees
45 administered by the department and required pursuant to this title, provided, the waiver is
46 warranted in the director's judgment. A fee shall be waived if one or more of the
47 following conditions applies to the service for which the fee was assessed:

- 48 1. The service was not performed;
- 49 2. The service is duplicative; that is, a service of similar body of work was
50 already performed and fees were collected for that service;
- 51 3. The service is not required for permit approval;
- 52 4. The service was based on a professional or processing error caused by the
53 department;
- 54 5. ~~((The service is limited to permit approval for the seismic retrofit of a single
55 family residence with the following characteristics: wood frame construction; light-
56 weight roof of regular shape; reinforced concrete foundation; no more than two stories in
57 height; and situated on a relatively level lot;~~
- 58 ~~6.))~~ 6.) The service was in response to a natural disaster as declared by the
59 ~~((E))~~ executive in accordance with K.C.C. 12.52.030; or
- 60 ~~((7.))~~ 6. The service was in response to a public health or safety emergency, for
61 which in the judgement of the director the public benefit of permitting services exceeds
62 the fee for the services.

63 B. An applicant must file a fee waiver request in writing no later than twenty-one
64 days after final approval of the permit by the department.

65 C. Any fee waiver decision shall be in writing and shall state a compelling need
66 or public purpose to be served by the waiver, if granted. The need or purpose must be

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67 consistent with standards established in subsection A. of this section and under K.C.C.
68 chapter 2.98.

69 D. The director's fee waiver decision is final unless the applicant then files with
70 the director a statement of appeal, together with the required appeal fee, and complies
71 with the appeal provisions in K.C.C. 20.22.080. The applicant may appeal a fee waiver
72 decision only if the director has denied all or a portion of the applicant's request.

73 E. In an appeal of a fee waiver decision, the burden is on the applicant to prove
74 that the particular fee was unreasonable or inconsistent with this title. If the applicant
75 fails to meet that burden, the examiner shall affirm the decision of the director. If the
76 examiner determines that a particular fee was unreasonable or inconsistent with the
77 provisions of this title, the examiner shall modify the fee, order the department to modify
78 the fee in accordance with the examiner's ruling or provide such other relief as reasonably
79 necessary. If the examiner determines that the applicant is the substantially prevailing
80 party, the department shall waive and refund the appeal fee. The examiner's decision is
81 final.

82 F. In an appeal under this section, the applicant may only challenge the
83 department's application of the development permit fees provided for in this title to the
84 applicant's permit and approval. The applicant may not challenge in an appeal under this
85 section the development permit fees in this title.

 105 zoning certification requiring historic research or review of other information is ~~((seven~~
 106 ~~hundred fifty-one))~~ eight hundred fifty-three dollars.

107 D. A fee of ~~((three hundred seventy-five))~~ four hundred twenty-six dollars shall be
 108 charged for each inspection of structures for housing code compliance, damage from flood,
 109 storm, fire or other natural disaster, or for each site visit conducted before permit
 110 application.

783 C. The surcharge amount shall be rounded to the nearest whole dollar for each fee
784 that is a whole dollar amount.

785 D. The surcharge applies to fee assessments made between January 1, 2023, and
786 December 31, 2024.

787 E. This section expires January 1, 2025.

788 **SECTION 31. Severability.** If any provision of this ordinance or its application to
789 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the

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790 application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

791 SECTION 32. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2023.


