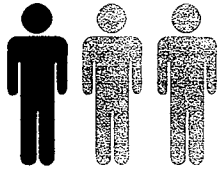


PROTECT AND STABILIZE

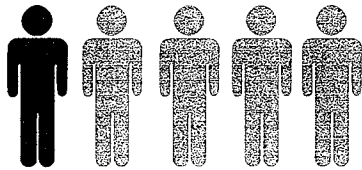

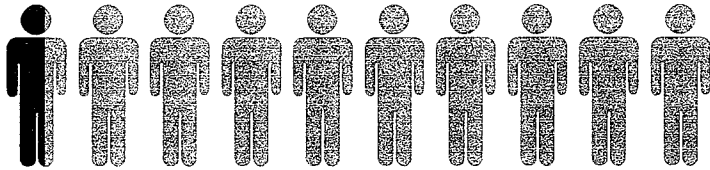
ONE IN THREE PEOPLE

LEGAL AID IS ONE OF THE TOP MOST REQUESTED SERVICES AT KING COUNTY 2-1-1. SINCE 2008, REQUESTS FOR LEGAL AID HAVE INCREASED SIGNIFICANTLY:

UNEMPLOYMENT ↑ 355%

BANKRUPTCY ↑ 490%

FORECLOSURE ↑ 131%

DISABILITY LIFELINE ↑ 617%

FOOD STAMPS ↑ 213%

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ADVOCACY ↑ 95%

NEARLY ONE IN TEN, OR ONE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND KING COUNTY RESIDENTS, ARE LIVING UNDER THE FEDERAL POVERTY LINE.

ALLIANCE FOR EQUAL JUSTICE

LEGAL AID PROVIDES AND GUARANTEES IMPARTIAL, UNBIASED, AND CONFIDENTIAL SUPPORT FOR VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS WHOSE STATE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFITS HAVE BEEN WRONGFULLY REDUCED, TERMINATED, OR DENIED. WE STRIVE TO END HOMELESSNESS, POVERTY, AND VIOLENCE THROUGH LEGAL AID AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT.

EASTSIDE LEGAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM:

PROVIDES CRITICAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE AND PROTECTION FOR LOW-INCOME SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

NORTHWEST IMMIGRANT RIGHTS PROJECT:

OFFERS IMMIGRATION LEGAL SERVICES TO SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN KING COUNTY TO HELP VICTIMS BECOME SELF-SUFFICIENT.

SEATTLE COMMUNITY LAW CENTER:

PROVIDES SOCIAL SECURITY ADVOCACY FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE HOMELESS OR LOW-INCOME SO THAT THEY MAY OBTAIN THE RESOURCES NECESSARY TO OVERCOME BARRIERS TO FINANCIAL AND MEDICAL STABILITY.

SOLID GROUND:

PROVIDES LEGAL HELP TO VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS WHOSE STATE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE BENEFITS HAVE BEEN WRONGFULLY REDUCED, TERMINATED, OR DENIED.

TEAMCHILD:

CREATES IMMEDIATE COST SAVINGS IN JUVENILE JUSTICE BY ENSURING THAT YOUTH HAVE CRITICAL SUPPORT IN THE COMMUNITY, LIKE SCHOOL, TREATMENT AND HOUSING.

UNEMPLOYMENT LAW PROJECT:

PROVIDES LEGAL HELP TO PEOPLE SEEKING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS WHO MAY BE VETERANS, HOMELESS, FOOD-INSECURE OR SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.
