A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees 11 assessed related to permits under the plumbing code. 12 B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C. 2.99.030. 13 SECTION 2. Ordinance 6746, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 16.32.080 are 14 each hereby amended to read as follows: 15 Fees - permit fees - double permit fee requirements - fees for reinspection

17	A. ((Permit fees.)) Effective January 1 ((1999)), 2003, and thereafter, an	
18	applicant for a permit to do work under this code shall pay for each permit, at the	time of
19	issuance, a fee in accordance with the following schedule, and at the rate provided	d for
20	each permit classification shown in the schedule:

38	Fees for inspection service outside regular working hours or for inspection service
39	requested but not covered by a permit will be charged at a rate equal to the cost of
40	performing the service.
41	Fees for permanent location inspection of factory housing or modular unit containing
42	plumbing –
43	For each single family dwelling or each modular unit containing plumbing 20.00
44	Plumbing permit includes onsite connections of building drain extensions, water
45	service and necessary as piping connections.
46	Additional plumbing fixtures installed after factory installation of plumbing for each
47	plumbing fixture or trap 10.00
48	Fees for reconnection and retest of plumbing systems in relocated buildings - For each
49	building containing plumbing 20.00
50	Plumbing permit includes on-site connections of building drain extensions, water
51	service and necessary gas piping connections.
52	Additional plumbing fixtures installed after relocation of building for each plumbing
53	fixture or trap 10.00
54	For the purpose of this section, "fixture" means an appliance that is connected
55	with a water, drain, or vent pipe, but a sillcock faucet or hose bibb is not considered a
56	fixture. A sanitary plumbing outlet on or to which a plumbing fixture or appliance may
57	be set or attached is a fixture.
58	B. ((Double permit fee requirements.)) A person who commenced work for
59	which a permit is required by this code without first having obtained the permit, shall
50	upon subsequent application for the permit pay double the fee fixed by the schedule of

fees for the work in subsection A of this section unless it is proved to the satisfaction of the administrative authority that the work was urgently necessary and that it was not practical to obtain a permit before the commencement of the work. In all such emergency cases, a permit shall be obtained as soon as it is practical to do so, and if there is an unreasonable delay in obtaining the permit, a double fee shall be charged as provided in this code.

C. ((Fees for reinspection service.)) A reinspection fee of ((forty)) one hundred dollars may be assessed for each inspection or reinspection if the portion of work for which inspection is called is not complete or if corrections called for are not made. This subsection does not require inspection fees the first time a job is rejected for failure to comply with this code, but as controlling the practice of calling for the inspection or reinspection.

Reinspection fees may be assessed if the permit is not properly posted on the work site, the work to be inspected is not under test, for failure to provide access on the date for which inspection is requested or for failure to make required corrections.

Requests for reinspection shall be made in writing upon forms furnished for that purpose, and shall be accompanied by the reinspection fee in accordance with this section. If reinspection fees have been assessed, additional inspection of the work shall not be performed until the required fees have been paid.

D. ((Refund of permit fees.)) If the work for which a permit fee has been paid is not started, the administrative authority, upon proper application for refund and surrender of the permit for cancellation, shall issue a refund. In determining the amount of refund

83	due, the administrative authority shall deduct the amount of the basic fee to cover the cos	
84	of administration of the permit. A refund shall not be made for an expired permit.	
85	SECTION 3. Ordinance 8330, Section 34 as amended, and K.C.C. 16.32.085 are	
86	each hereby amended to read as follows:	
87	Gas piping permit and inspection fees. Health department gas piping permit and	
88	inspection fees. ((Effective January 1, 1998.))	
89	A. Additional outlets (each) \$10.00	
90	B. Each gas piping permit (basic fee for one	
91	((through four)) outlet((s)) ((\$75.00)) \$95.00	
92	C. A reinspection fee of ((forty)) one hundred dollars may be assessed for each	
93	inspection or reinspection when ((such)) the portion of work for which inspection is	
94	called is not complete or when corrections called for are not made. This subsection is no	
95	to be interpreted as requiring inspection fees the first time a job is rejected for failure to	
96	comply with the requirements of this code, but as controlling the practice of calling for	
97	inspection or reinspection.	
98	Reinspection fees may be assessed when the permit is not properly posted on the	
99	work site, the work to be inspected is not under test, for failure to provide access on the	
100	date for which inspection is requested, or for failure to make required corrections. To	
101	obtain a reinspection the applicant shall file an application ((therefore)) for the	
102	reinspection in writing upon a form furnished for that purpose, and pay the reinspection	
103	fee in accordance with this section. In instances where reinspection fees have been	
104	assessed, ((no)) additional inspection of the work ((will)) shall not be performed until the	

required fees have been paid.

SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2003.
