### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Ordinance 18710

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, April 16, 2018, beginning at 1:30 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2017-0436 (Ordinance 18710) an ordinance relating to the County's subdivision code.

#### SUMMARY:

Ordinance 18710 amends the King County subdivision code and delegates final plat approval to the Director of the Department of Permitting and Environmental Review (DPER), after the director certifies that the final plat serves the public health, safety and general welfare, that it is in the public interest, and that it is consistent with the applicable laws, regulations and adopted policies.
