1 STRIKING AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2011-0125, VERSION

3 On page 1, beginning on line 9, strike everything through page 3, line 32, and insert:

4 "BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Findings:

6 A. The city of Enumclaw, Washington, by Resolution No. 1406, determined that  
7 it is in the public interest and general welfare to provide for the annexation of the city of  
8 Enumclaw into the King County rural library and initiated the annexation into the library  
9 district, and the metropolitan King County council enacted Ordinance 17036 as an  
10 emergency ordinance so a special election could be held on the question of this  
11 annexation on April 26, 2011.

12 B. At its March 7, 2011, council meeting the city council of Enumclaw adopted a  
13 motion directing that its administration notify King County that the city withdrew from  
14 the April 26 special election. The city council also directed the administration to draft a  
15 resolution withdrawing from the April 26 election. On March 9, 2011, the city  
16 administrator of the city of Enumclaw notified the clerk of the county council that the  
17 city no longer wished to proceed with the special election on April 26, 2011. The city

18 council is scheduled at its meeting of March 14, 2011, to consider and adopt a resolution  
19 withdrawing from the special election. Cancellation of the election requires immediate  
20 enactment of this ordinance, repealing the ordinance that called for the election,  
21 Ordinance 17036.

22 C. The deadline for notifying the department of elections of the cancellation of  
23 the election was March 11, 2011. The council chair has provided informal notice to the  
24 director of elections of the city of Enumclaw's desire to cancel the election. This  
25 ordinance must be enacted as an emergency ordinance to ratify this notice.

26 SECTION 2. Ordinance 17036, Section 1, Ordinance 17036, Section 2,  
27 Ordinance 17036, Section 3, Ordinance 17036, Section 4, Ordinance 17036, Section 5,  
28 Ordinance 17036, Section 6, Ordinance 17036, Section 7, and Ordinance 17036, Section  
29 8, are each hereby repealed.

30 SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect upon the adoption of a  
31 resolution by the city of Enumclaw withdrawing from the April 26 election or requesting  
32 cancellation of the April 26 special election on annexation into the King County rural  
33 library district.

34 SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency  
35 exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,  
36 health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public  
37 institutions."

38 **EFFECT: Adds language outlining the City's actions to cancel the election and adds**  
39 **an effective date section.**
