### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ENACTMENT ORDINANCE 18835

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the King County Council Chambers, 10th Floor, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on Monday November 5, 2018 at 11:30 A.M. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance No. 2018-0465 (Ordinance 18835), adopting the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget and making appropriations for the operation of county agencies and departments and capital improvements for the fiscal biennium beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2020.

#### SUMMARY

The 2019-2020 operating budget is approximately \$10 billion. Of the operating budget authority, approximately \$1.9 billion is for the General Fund. The 2019-2020 capital program budget calls for capital outlays of about \$1.9 billion. Of the capital program budget authority, approximately \$682.6 million is for the Wastewater Treatment capital program, \$179.2 million is for the Transit revenue fleet, and \$331.7 million is for the Transit capital program.
