



SE 40th St. at this location is a 60 foot wide right-of-way extending 130 feet west of the west right-of-way line of 161st Ave SE. It dead ends at a drop-off against a school yard and because of this, it will probably never be extended beyond it's current terminus. There are only two properties abutting this road, the applicant's parcel on the north and another private residence on the south side. The two property owners should get together and request to have the entire road vacated.
