1 AN ORDINANCE adopting the King County Executive 2 Branch EEO/Affirmative Action Plan January 1, 2005 to 3 December 31, 2006; amending Ordinance 14571, Section 2. 4 5 STATEMENT OF FACTS: 7 1. The Office of Federal Contract Compliance, pursuant to 41 C.F.R. 60, 8 requires federal grant recipients to develop and implement an affirmative 9 action plan. 10 2. Initiative 200 allows for public employers to establish affirmative 11 action plans to meet federal grant requirements. 12 3. King County receives federal grants directly from the federal 13 government and indirectly through state and local agencies. 14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 15 SECTION 1.
