1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2003 levy of property
2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2004; and
3 amending Ordinance 14814, Sections 1, 2 and 3.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. The county assessor of King County has certified to the
8 metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as
9 finally equalized amounts to \$((~~235,937,628,670~~)) 234,777,040,163 and as adjusted for
10 senior citizens exemptions provided for in RCW 84.36.381 and for omitted assessments
11 in accordance with RCW 84.40.080 is \$((~~233,030,173,168~~)) 232,927,602,043.

12 SECTION 2. The metropolitan King County council imposes the levies necessary
13 to fund estimated expenditures for the year 2004 as listed in this section. These amounts
14 do not include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including
15 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In
16 accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes
17 available to the county related to new construction, improvements to property and any

18 increase in the assessed value of state assessed property. In calculating the amount of
19 regular property tax monies needed, the council was cognizant of this sum and it is
20 therefore included in the following levy totals.


Ordinance 14833 was introduced on 11/24/2003 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 1/26/2004, by the following vote:




