NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-28 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act on Tuesday, December 8, 2020, beginning at 1:00 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0295 (Ordinance 19217); an ordinance renewing for six months an existing moratorium prohibiting the acceptance of applications for or establishment of new or expansion of existing wineries, breweries, distilleries and remote tasting rooms, as primary uses or as home occupations or home industries; and prohibiting temporary use permits for wineries, breweries, distilleries and remote tasting room uses under the King County Code. The Council then adopted this Ordinance at the December 8, 2020 meeting.

SUMMARY:
Ordinance 19217 renews for six months an existing moratorium prohibiting the acceptance of applications for or establishment of new or expansion of existing wineries, breweries, distilleries and remote tasting rooms, as primary uses or as home occupations or home industries; and prohibiting temporary use permits for wineries, breweries, distilleries and remote tasting room uses under the King County Code.
