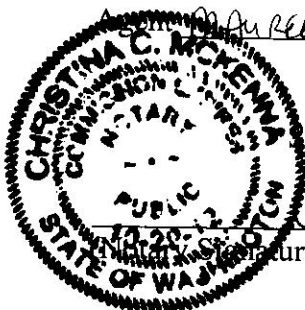

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 5th day of November, 2012, at 11:00 a.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404, revising the boundaries and purposes of the King County Transportation Benefit District (TBD) established by Ordinance 16742 (codified at K.C.C. 2.121).

SUMMARY

Ordinance 16742 (codified at K.C.C. 2.121) approved by the Council on January 4, 2010, established the King County Transportation Benefit District including the entire unincorporated area of King County as the boundaries existed on that date. The purpose of the TBD was to fund certain transportation improvement projects in unincorporated King County, which were listed in Attachment A to Ordinance 16742. The TBD could decide to levy a vehicle fee of up to \$20 per vehicle per year to fund the TBD's operations and the construction of identified transportation improvements, but has not exercised this authority.

Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404 would amend Ordinance 16742 (K.C.C. 2.121.010) to change the TBD boundaries to include the unincorporated area as of the effective date of Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404 or as they may exist following future annexations or incorporations, thus removing from the TBD areas that were annexed into cities after the effective date of Ordinance 16742.

Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404 would further amend Ordinance 16742 (K.C.C. 2.121.020) to state that the purpose of the TBD is to fund transportation improvements specified by motion approved annually by the governing board of the TBD, and deleting the reference to Attachment A of Ordinance 16742.

Proposed Ordinance 2012-0404 would add a section to K.C.C. 2.121 to specify the purposes of the transportation improvements funded by the TBD. These include protecting the County's long-term investments in infrastructure, reducing the risk of transportation facility failure, and other purposes.
