NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that public hearing before the Metropolitan King County Council will be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue Room 1001 on the 27th day of June 2023, at 1:30 p.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2022-0309, concerning the 2022 Transportation Concurrency Map Update. Remote public testimony on Zoom will also be accepted. Information on the public hearing and how to submit public testimony can be found at this website: https://www.kingcounty.gov/council/committees/full_council.aspx.

It is expected that the Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the June 27, 2023, meeting following the public hearing.

The Transportation Concurrency Management Program for unincorporated King County established in K.C.C Chapter 14.70 addresses State Growth Management Act requirements that transportation infrastructure meet the needs of planned development. King County's current concurrency system evaluates travel time in thirteen travel sheds or geographic area within which all development would be likely to use or be affected by traffic on arterials within the travel shed. The Proposed Ordinance adopts a new concurrency map for unincorporated King County that is derived from travel time data collected in March 2022.
