1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of  
2 NE 160th Street, File V-2531, Petitioners: John and  
3 Elizabeth Bell.

6 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

- 7 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of NE 160th  
8 Street hereinafter described.  
9 2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies  
10 serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required  
11 within the vacation area.  
12 3. The department of transportation records indicates that King County  
13 has not been maintaining NE 160th Street. The records indicate that no  
14 public funds have been expended for its acquisition.  
15 4. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the  
16 right-of-way useless as part of King County road system and believes the

17 public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax  
18 rolls.

19 5. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with  
20 K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty  
21 percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way, which was  
22 determined from records of the department of assessments. King County  
23 is in receipt of \$9,008.33 from the petitioners.

24 Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was  
25 held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 17th day of October,  
26 2006.

27 In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation the  
28 council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King  
29 County to grant said petition.

30 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

31 SECTION 1. The council, on the effective date of this ordinance, hereby vacates  
32 and abandons that portion of the north 6.00 feet of NE 160th Street as conveyed to King  
33 County by the recording of King County Short Plat 387035, recording number  
34 8805261153, records of King County, Washington as described below:

35 That portion of the NE 160th Street right-of-way as dedicated in King  
36 County Short Plat 387035, recording number 8805261153, records of  
37 King County Washington, bounded by the following described line.


38 Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 1, of said Short Plat; Thence  
39 easterly, along the south line of said lot, a distance of 625.85 feet; Thence

40           northeasterly, along a tangential curve to the left, with a radius of 25.00  
 41           feet, a distance of 38.65 feet; Thence S 02°00'38" W a distance of 6.00  
 42           feet; Thence southwesterly, along a non-tangential curve to the right, with  
 43           a radius of 25.00 feet, a distance of 38.65 feet; Thence N 89°23'57" W a  
 44           distance of 625.85 feet to the east margin of 152nd Avenue NE; Thence  
 45           north along said east margin 6.00 feet, to the point of beginning.





**DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:**

The Department of Transportation's written report to the King County Hearing Examiner for Item No. V-2531 was received by the Examiner on September 22, 2006.

PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department's Report and examining available information on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject as follows:

The hearing on Item No. V-2531 was opened by the Examiner at 1:47 p.m., October 17, 2006, in the Hearing Examiner's Conference Room, 400 Yesler Way, Seattle, WA 98104, and closed at 1:51 p.m., except that it was continued administratively for receipt of an affidavit of the required Notice of Hearing, which was received on October 19, 2006. Participants at the public hearing and the exhibits offered and entered are listed in the attached minutes. A verbatim recording of the hearing is available in the office of the Hearing Examiner.

FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATION: Having reviewed the record in this matter, the Examiner now makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS:

## 1. General Information:

Road name and location:	Portion of Northeast 160th Street
Right of way classification:	C
Area:	3,905.10 square feet
Compensation:	\$9,008.33

2. The Notice of Hearing on the Department's report was given as required by law, and a hearing on the report was conducted by the Examiner on behalf of the Metropolitan King County Council.
3. Except as provided below, the Examiner adopts and incorporates herein by this reference the facts set forth in the Department's report to the Examiner for the October 17, 2006, public hearing and the statement of facts contained in Proposed Ordinance No. 2006-0402. The Department's report will be attached to those copies of this report and recommendation that are submitted to the County Council.
4. Maps showing the vicinity of the proposed vacation and the specific area to be vacated appear in the hearing record as exhibit nos. 7 and 12.
5. The subject right-of-way is not opened, constructed or maintained for public use, and is not used informally for access to any property.
6. Vacation of the right-of-way would have no adverse effect on the provision of access and fire and emergency services to the abutting subject property and surrounding area.
7. The right-of-way is not necessary for the present or future road system for travel or utilities purposes.
8. No easements are necessary to be retained for the construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.

9. The compensation required by law to be paid as a condition precedent to vacation of this road has been deposited with King County.

CONCLUSION:

1. The right-of-way segment subject to this petition is useless as part of the King County road system, and the public will be benefited by its vacation.

RECOMMENDATION:

APPROVE proposed Ordinance No. 2006-0402 to vacate the subject road right-of-way.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL  
AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) *on or before November 7, 2006*. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council *on or before November 14, 2006*.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
