## AD TEXT

### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 5th day of November, 2012, at 11:00 a.m., pursuant to RCW 89.08.400 and .405, to consider a system of rates and charges proposed by the King Conservation District (KCD) for the years 2013-2017 ("the KCD proposal") in conjunction with the public hearing on Proposed Ordinance 2012-0432 which would set the system of rates and charges for the KCD and their duration.

#### SUMMARY

The KCD proposal requests that the Metropolitan King County Council consider and approve a natural resource conservation system of rates and charges for the King Conservation District in the following amounts: agricultural parcels, \$10.00 per parcel; residential parcels, \$9.62 per parcel; institutional/ public parcels, \$9.42 per parcel; commercial parcels, \$9.40 per parcel; open space parcels, \$9.37 per parcel; vacant/undeveloped parcels, \$8.65 per parcel; and forested parcels, \$0.00 per parcel. The system of rates and charges would be effective from January 1, 2013, through December 31, 2017. The following lands would be exempted from the system of rates and charges assessment: parcels owned by federally recognized Native American tribes or members of such tribes that are located within the historical boundaries of a reservation, and forest land parcels that are in the King County Assessor's property classifications of Forest Land (Class-RCW 84.33), 324; Forest Land (Desig-RCW 84.33), 325; and Open Space Timber Land/Greenbelt, 328.

The KCD proposal provides that the use of revenues from the system of rates and charges would be to implement a proposed program of work and budget.
