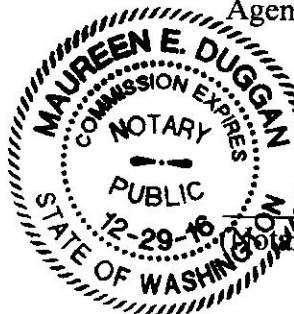

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 10th day of November, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0424, an ordinance relating to zoning; continuing a temporary use permit for homeless encampments; amending Ordinance 15170, Section 10, and K.C.C. 21A.45.050, Ordinance 15170, Section 16, and Ordinance 15170, Section 17, and adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 21A.45.

SUMMARY

The proposed ordinance identifies temporary homeless encampments as interim survival mechanisms that are part of the county-wide strategy of ending homelessness. The proposed ordinance will extend King County's existing regulations related to temporary homeless encampments through January 1, 2025.

The proposed ordinance will add provisions related to public notice and enforcement of health and safety violations, and will extend the length of time an encampment can be located at a single site.
