Definitions

	Description
Euthanasia	The humane death of an animal accomplished by a method that involves instantaneous unconsciousness and immediate death, or by a method that causes painless loss of consciousness, and death during the loss of consciousness.
Euthanasia Ledger/Log	Document that accounts for each euthanasia transaction including animal description and amount of euthanasia drug used.
KCACC	King County Animal Care and Control, a work center in the Animal Services and Programs Section of the Records and Licensing Services Division.
Shelter Manager	The KCACC Manager or Superintendent responsible for shelter and field programs and who co-supervises Clinic Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians.
WSBP Registrant	The King County Animal Care and Control employee(s) authorized by the Shelter Manager, and on record with the Washington State Board of Pharmacy, responsible for the ordering, possession, safe storage and utilization of sodium pentobarbital.
Sodium pentobarbital	A controlled substance used in the humane euthanasia of animals. Comes under several commercial names including Fatal-Plus, Euthanol, Beuthanasia, and Sleep-Away.
Sodium Pentobarbital Distribution Log	A log accounting for the initial receipt from the vendor of individual bottles of sodium pentobarbital and the bottle number, date, and name of each person assigned a bottle.

Policy

1. All shelter staff shall adhere to federal and state regulations related to the use, recordkeeping, and storage of controlled substances.

Procedure

1.0 Sodium pentobarbital ordering, distribution, and administration

Shelter Manager	 Maintain current Controlled Drug registration certificates with US Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration and WA Department of Health (Appendix A).
	 Designate personnel with sodium pentobarbital registrant status. Provide information to the Washington State Board of Pharmacy (WSBP).
	Approve staff members who are authorized to perform euthanasia. Euthanasia approval is based on the following criteria:
	a. Completion of State-certified euthanasia training b. Approval by KCACC Clinic Veterinarian
WSBP registrant	4) Order replacement supply of sodium pentobarbital using DEA Form 222 and other standard internal order forms required by the Washington State Board of Pharmacy and/or U.S. Drug Enforcement.
	5) Maintain a separate file for all sodium pentobarbital invoices with the respective DEA 222 order forms for 3 years.
WSBP registrant or designee	Upon receipt of shipment of sodium pentobarbital: a. Conduct inventory to ensure quantity ordered was received.
	 b. Assign and write a unique number on each bottle. c. Add new quantity/bottle numbers to the Sodium Pentobarbital Distribution Log.
	d. Secure bottles in locked cabinet in shelter supervisor's office.
Euthanasia approved officer	Place request for initial bottle of sodium pentobarbital, or replacement bottle, with WSBP registrant or designee.
WSBP registrant or designee	8) If request is for replacement bottle, review Euthanasia Ledger/Log (Appendix B) to verify proper documentation of preceding bottle of sodium pentobarbital and that balance corresponds with amount distributed.
	9) Log each issuance of sodium pentobarbital in ink in the Sodium Pentobarbital Distribution Log (Appendix C). Include: a. Date b. Bottle number
	c. Officer name bottle issued to
	Note: Issue in reverse order (larger number issued first). Place reorder request through contracted vendor when bottle #30 issued.


