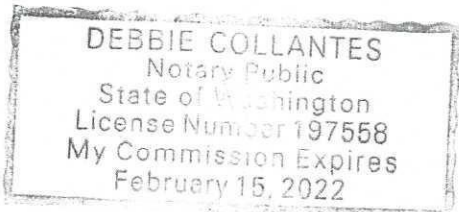

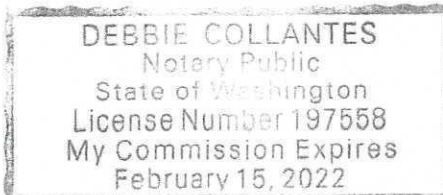

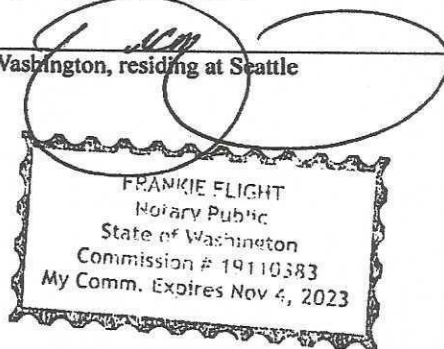

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on the 13th day of July, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0417, an ordinance relating to electric vehicle parking regulations in unincorporated King County. The public hearing is planned to either be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Room 1001, Seattle, Washington; or the hearing may be required to be held remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-29 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act. Information on this public hearing, including how to submit public testimony and attend the meeting, will be posted on the Council's website ahead of the hearing. It is expected that the full Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the July 13, 2021 meeting following the public hearing.

SUMMARY:
King County is proposing this ordinance to require electric vehicle charging infrastructure to be installed during the construction of certain types of new or substantially improved buildings and new or expanded parking areas. Specifically, the proposed ordinance would:

- Require new townhouses to provide one electric vehicle-ready parking space per dwelling unit;
- For new or substantially improved buildings for apartment dwelling units, or projects that propose a fifty percent or more expansion in paved surface parking area for such buildings, require ten percent of total parking spaces to be electric vehicle supply equipment spaces and an additional twenty-five percent of total parking spaces to be electric-vehicle ready; and
- For new or substantially improved buildings for nonresidential uses, group residential uses, or temporary lodging uses, or for expansion of a parking area for one of these by fifty percent or more, or for a new commuter parking lot or automotive parking uses, require five percent of total parking to be electric vehicle supply equipment spaces and an additional ten percent of total parking spaces to be electric-vehicle ready.

The regulations would not apply to common-wall residential buildings that serve townhouse, apartment, group residential or temporary lodging uses and that consist of four or fewer units, do not exceed two stories in height, are less than five thousand square feet in area and have a one-hour fire-resistive occupancy separation between units.

Additionally, modifications to the requirements are allowed in certain instances associated with townhouse developments and for uses with six or fewer total parking spaces.

FINAL CONSIDERATION:

In addition to the proposed amendments contained in the Proposed Ordinance, Councilmembers may offer additional amendments for consideration by the Council. As a result, persons interested in any of the issues raised in the Proposed Ordinance should make their views known at the public hearing on July 13, 2021. Amendments that may be considered for adoption by the Council on July 13, 2021 or thereafter include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- An amendment to mitigate the cost of electric vehicle infrastructure on affordable housing projects.
- Any amendment contained in the Executive's proposed version of the subject legislation.
- Any amendment offered, or relating to topics discussed, during the review of the subject legislation in committee.
- Any matter preserved for consideration by the Council by a member during previous committee meetings.

The Metropolitan King County Council hereby gives notice of judicial vacancy in the Southwest Electoral District of the King County District Court. The Council currently intends to fill this vacancy pursuant to state law and county code. To be eligible to serve as a district court judge in this position, an individual must be a registered voter and legal resident of the Southwest Division's electoral district and a lawyer admitted to practice law in Washington State. RCW 3.34.060; K.C.C. 2.68.075. The election precincts that make up the Southwest Division's electoral district are set forth in Section 1.C.2 of King County Ordinance 19995. Pursuant to K.C.C. 2.70.020, to be considered for appointment, a candidate must have a current rating of, at a minimum, "qualified" for a district court judicial position from the King County Bar Association and at least one other bar association operating in King County with an eligible judicial candidate evaluation process, as defined in K.C.C. 2.70.020.F.2. Under the County Code, ratings are "current" until the expiration date stated in the rating communication or until three years after the date the rating communication was issued if no expiration date is stated. Any individual wishing to be considered for appointment must deliver to the clerk of the council, in electronic form, the following application materials:

1. A letter of interest, which must specify the division of the district court to which the applicant is requesting appointment and should explain why the individual wishes to serve as a district court judge, how the applicant is qualified to do so and specify the division of the district court to which the applicant is requesting appointment;
2. The individual's resume;
3. A copy of the completed responses to questionnaires submitted to the King County Bar Association to obtain its rating;
4. A copy of the communication from the King County Bar Association and from at least one bar association defined in K.C.C. 2.70.020.F.2 informing the individual of the individual's rating for appointment to the district court; and
5. Any supporting information the individual would like the council to consider.

These application materials must be received by the clerk of the council, in electronic form, not later than 4:30 p.m., August 9, 2021. The clerk's email address is: clerk@kingcounty.gov
