Re: State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Threshold Determination of Non-significance (DNS) for a non-project action identified as:

As a SEPA official within the Permitting Division of the Department of Local Services, I was tasked with performing the SEPA review and threshold determination under SEPA for the Proposed Ordinance PO 2024-0387, affecting the regulation of Winery, Brewery, and Distillery uses in unincorporated King County.

As part of that process, I reviewed the SEPA checklist, proposed ordinance, existing codes, regulations and policies. I also reviewed the history of adopted and proposed ordinances and related SEPA reviews and decisions associated and referenced in the SEPA checklist.

A DNS was issued and published on April 9, 2025, with a comment period ending April 23, 2025. No substantive comments were received. No further action as it relates to this SEPA review and the DNS is necessary at this time.
