A. GENERAL INFORMATION

B. HISTORY AND OVERVIEW

R.C.W. 36.87 establishes the right of property owners to petition a county legislative body for the vacation of road rights-of-way. K.C.C. 14.40 establishes King County policies and procedures for accomplishing same.

The petition was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on January 21, 2021, by Nir and Sarina Ziv, seeking the vacation of a portion of 172nd Ave SE in the Renton area of unincorporated King County.

King County acquired the subject right-of-way by dedication in the 1957 plat, Renton Suburban Tracts Division No. 2, as recorded in Volume 58 of Plats at Page 97. Exhibit 5. The plat dedicates to the use of the public forever, all streets and avenues shown thereon and the use thereof for all public purposes not inconsistent with the use thereof for public highway purposes.

The subject portion of right-of-way qualifies as unopened and unmaintained road right-of-way and does not provide access to any properties.

In early 2022, Nir and Sarina Ziv sold their property to Luong The Dang and Guo Zhen Huang. Luong The Dang and Guo Zhen Huang then signed a Revised Petition and assumed the role of Petitioner for the vacation of the portion of 172nd Ave SE. Exhibits 13 and 14.

The vacation area is adjacent to the portion of 172nd Ave SE vacated under vacation file V-2719, King County Ordinance 19167. Said vacation area attached to Parcel 7230200590. In accordance with KCC 14.40.015C, the owner of Parcel 7230200590, Mr. Brian Kelderman, was provided with a copy of the Notice of Hearing for this vacation petition and the County Road Engineer's Report by letter dated October 23, 2023. Exhibit 18.

C. NOTICE

Notice of this hearing was posted at the approximate ends of the proposed vacation area on October 23, 2023, see Exhibit 17, and published in accordance with requirements of RCW 36.87.060. See Exhibit 19.

D. REVIEWING AGENCIES AND COMMENTS

Roads solicited comments from agencies within King County and utilities serving the area regarding the impacts of vacating the subject area. The responses received are listed below. No utility or agency identified infrastructure within the subject right-of-way or requested an easement over the vacation area.

Roads did not receive responses from King County Fire District No. 25, King County Water District 90, and the following King County agencies: Executive Services, Division of Real Estate Services; Department of Natural Resources and Parks, Open Space, and Water and Land Resources; Metro Transit: and the Department of Local Services Road Services Division Archeologist. A copy of the Notice is included as Exhibit 8.

E. COMPENSATION

Utilizing the model prepared by King County Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget (PSB), Roads solicited from the Assessor's Office a determination of value for the vacation area that will attach to the property owned by Petitioners. See Exhibit 9.

The property of Petitioners, parcel number 7229800505, will receive approximately 3,073 square feet if the petition is approved. The Assessor's Office determined that adding 3,073 square feet to the property would result in a \$7,000 increase in value. The valuation as applied to the compensation model prepared by the County Office of Performance Strategy and Budget (PSB), see attached, with offsets for management and maintenance costs and future expected property tax,

results in a charge of \$2,767 in compensation to Petitioners should the 3,073 square foot area of unopened undeveloped right-of-way be vacated. See Exhibit 10.

F. COUNTY ROAD ENGINEER RECOMMENDATION

The County Road Engineer has determined that the subject portion of right-of-way is useless to the county transportation system. It is the recommendation of the County Road Engineer and the Director of Road Services that, consistent with the application of the PSB compensation model as applied to this road vacation petition, the subject portion of right-of-way be vacated with the requirement of additional payment from the Petitioners as set forth above. The full County Road Engineer's Report is attached as Exhibit 12.




