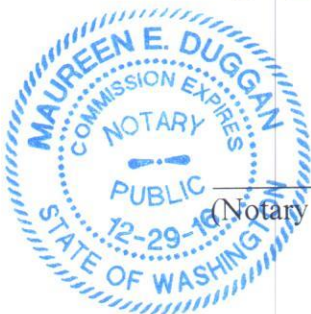

Ordinance 18282

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, May 9, 2016, beginning at 1:30 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2016-0235 (Ordinance 18282) an ordinance relating to the creation of Lake Management District No. 2 in the Lake Geneva watershed.

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 18282 creates the Lake Geneva Lake Management District (Lake Management District No. 2). The boundaries of the district include all lakeside parcels to Lake Geneva. The duration of the district shall be 2016 through 2026. The activities to be financed by the district shall be those described in the lake management plan adopted by Ordinance 18282. Special assessments of \$14,500 are proposed to be collected annually to finance the district activities for ten years, with the total amount to be collected during the life of the district being \$145,000. The district will be administered by King County through the Department of Natural Resources and Parks. A property owner's advisory committee will provide advice to the County, including the work program and budget.
