It is expected that the Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the June 16, 2026 meeting following the public hearing.

**SUMMARY:**

The Proposed Ordinance would adopt changes relating to the organization of the Executive's Office, including changes to the Regional Land Use Division.

The Proposed Ordinance would do the following:

Amend sections of King County Code to consolidate five standalone executive offices into the Executive's Office. The offices are:

- Office of Climate;
- Office of Economic Opportunity and Creative Economy;
- Office of Equity, Racial, and Social Justice;
- Office of Labor Relations; and
- Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget (including the Regional Land Use Division) into the Executive's Office.

The general functions of most standalone offices would continue in the Executive Office or in Executive Departments.

**FINAL ACTION:**

Prior to final action, Councilmembers may offer amendments for consideration by the Council. Persons wishing to testify on the Proposed Ordinance should attend the public hearing in person or remotely on June 16, 2026 or provide testimony in writing prior to the hearing. Amendments that may be considered for adoption by the Council include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- Engraving changes made by other ordinances.
- Making technical corrections, clarifications to terminology, and streamlining of language that does not change the intent.
- Any amendment offered, or relating to topics discussed, during the review of the subject legislation in committee.
- Any matter preserved for consideration by the Council by a member during previous committee meetings.
- Any amendment contained in the Executive's version of the subject legislation.
- Any amendment related to retaining and/or modifying Executive offices proposed for removal from King County Code or related concepts.

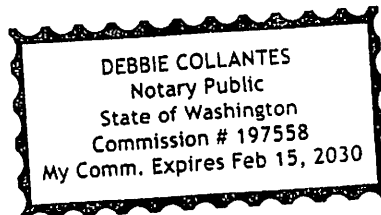

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing before the Metropolitan King County Council will be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue Room 1001, on the 23rd day of June 2026, at 1:30 p.m. to consider the adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2026-0103, which establishes the sewer rate and capacity charge for the year 2027. Remote public testimony on Zoom will also be accepted. **SUMMARY**

Proposed Ordinance 2026-0103 would make a determination of the sewer rate for the year 2027 that must be charged in order to meet the monetary requirements (administration, operating, and maintenance, repair and replacement costs) of the County's sewage disposal program. The proposed sewer rate for 2027 is \$70.65 per month per residential customer equivalent (RCE). The adopted sewer rate for 2026 is \$62.66 per RCE per month.

The proposed ordinance would also set the capacity charge for sewer connections occurring between and including January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026. The capacity charge is the fee that is assessed against customers establishing new connections to ensure that those customers bear their equitable share of the cost of new capacity-related sewage facilities necessary to serve them. The proposed capacity charge for 2027 is \$83.10 per month per RCE for fifteen years. The adopted capacity charge for 2026 is \$77.99 per RCE per month for fifteen years.

**Final Action:**

Prior to final action, Councilmembers may offer amendments for consideration by the Council. Persons wishing to testify on the Proposed Ordinance should attend the public hearing in person or remotely on June 23, 2026, or provide testimony in writing prior to the hearing.
