1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the county property tax
2 levies for collection in 2016, and implementing RCW
3 84.55.120.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. The council is under an obligation by charter to enact revenue
6 measures that support the budget appropriation ordinance for the 2015/2016 budget.
7 This ordinance sets the amount of property tax to be collected for the regular property
8 tax levy, the road district levy, the conservation futures levy, the emergency medical
9 services levy and the ferry district. In accordance with RCW 84.55.120, the council has
10 given proper notice of this ordinance to the public.

11 SECTION 2. For collection of the property tax levies in 2016, the council hereby
12 authorizes property tax changes compared to the amounts authorized for collection in 2015 as
13 follows:

Regular (includes new 2015 voter-approved Emergency Radio levy, under Ordinance 17993 and Best Start for Kids Levy under Ordinance 18088)	\$93,031,129	20.12%	\$564,689,848

Regular - Transit	\$193,554	0.74%	\$26,966,199
Road District	\$1,450,804	1.79%	\$82,632,870
Conservation Futures	\$132,669	0.72%	\$18,887,515
Emergency Medical Services	\$882,069	0.76%	\$119,948,265
Ferry District	\$0	0.0%	\$1,183,252

14 The changes shown above are exclusive of any amounts resulting from new construction valued
 15 in 2015, any increases in value of state-assessed property for 2016 and any amounts necessary to
 16 fund tax refunds paid in 2015.

17 SECTION 3. Upon enactment, the clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to
18 the assessor in accordance with RCW 84.52.070.
