Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:40 p.m.

Roll Call

Flag Salute and Pledge of Allegiance

Ms. Patterson led the flag salute and Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Approval of Minutes of January 16, 2007

Ms. Patterson moved to approve the minutes of the January 16, 2007 meeting as presented. Seeing no objection, the Chair so ordered.

2. Special Item

Presentation of a Recognition to Former Washington State Governor and Former King County Executive John Spellman

Ms. Hague and Mr. von Reichbauer acknowledged the contributions of former Washington State Governor John Spellman and presented a video on his achievements as the first King County Executive. Ms. Hague explained that because Governor Spellman was instrumental in creating the Kingdome, he was reluctant to be involved in its demolition. She then presented him with a framed ceiling tile from the Kingdome as a memento. Mr. von Reichbauer and Ms. Hague read the Recognition and Governor Spellman spoke briefly. Mrs. Spellman and other family members were invited to the podium and King County Prosecuting Attorney Norm Maleng made concluding remarks. Mr. von Reichbauer and Ms. Hague thanked their staffs for arranging and organizing the event.

3. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

Ms. Patterson reported on the January 18, 2007 meeting of the Board of Health. She indicated the Board elected officers, and she was re-elected as Chair. Ms. Lambert, Dr. George Counts, Lake Forest Park Mayor Hutchinson and Seattle City Councilmember Tom Rasmussen were elected Vice Chairs. The Board received a draft 2007 work program which will be adopted next month. Ms. Patterson explained that the three primary focuses for the year are the operational master plan, eating health and active living initiatives, and public health financing. The Board also had its ongoing briefing on trans fat.

Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Corridor Advisory Committee. She indicated the committee's work is finished and has made its final recommendations to the Puget Sound Regional Council regarding uses for the trail corridor. She explained that the recommendations made to the PSRC for possible uses for short term, medium term and long term may be adopted into the regional long range plan. She also explained what the final recommendations were for each segment.

4. Plat Tracing
