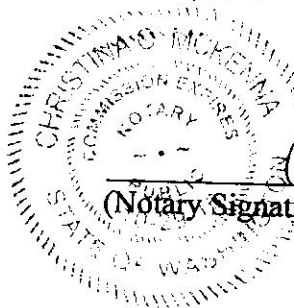

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1200, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 17th day of February, 2015, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2015-0038, Hanford #1 Combined Sewer Overflow Control (CSO) Project - Property Acquisition and Condemnation, authorizing the condemnation of real property to obtain easements and other rights in property for the construction of the Hanford #1 Project, located in Seattle, Washington in King County. The King County parcel numbers that are the subject matter of this ordinance are as follows: 9122000980; 9122000975; 5394600175

SUMMARY

The Hanford #1 Project is a CSO control project to provide conveyance and storage of sewage and municipal stormwater from the Mt. Baker and northern Rainier Valley neighborhoods thereby limiting discharges to no more than once per year into the Duwamish River. Adoption of this ordinance will also ensure that the Wastewater Treatment Division of the Department of Natural Resources and Parks can comply with the construction schedule for the Hanford #1 Project as directed in the federal CSO consent decree that King County, the United States Department of Justice, the Environmental Protection Agency and the Washington State Department of Ecology entered into in July 2013. The Hanford #1 Project is necessary for a public purpose and is in the best interest of the residents and wastewater ratepayers of King County.

The Metropolitan King County Council intends to take final action to authorize condemnation of the properties listed in this notice.
