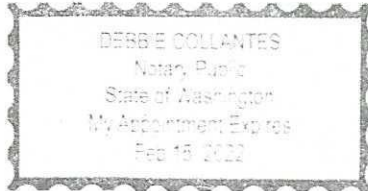

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on the 17th day of August, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2021-0163, an ordinance relating to development regulations for search and rescue facilities in unincorporated King County. The public hearing is planned to either be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Room 1001, Seattle, Washington; or the hearing may be required to be held remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-28 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act. Information on this public hearing, including how to submit public testimony and attend the meeting, will be posted on the Council's website ahead of the hearing. It is expected that the full Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the August 17, 2021 meeting following the public hearing.

SUMMARY:
King County is proposing this ordinance to allow search and rescue facilities to locate in the Rural Area (RA) zone of unincorporated King County, subject to conditions. A search and rescue facility would be defined as a multiuse facility operated by a nonprofit organization or organizations that, under direction from or in collaboration with a law enforcement agency, utilize emergency workers to conduct search and rescue operations as described in chapter 118-04 WAC.

Such facilities would be subject to the following conditions:

- A minimum lot size of four and one half acres;
- Structures and parking areas must maintain a minimum distance of seventy-five feet from interior lot lines that adjoin rural area and residential zones, unless located in a building designated as an historic resource;
- Use of a search and rescue facility is limited to activities directly relating to the search and rescue organization, except that the facility may be used by law enforcement and other public emergency responders for training and operations;
- Type II landscaping is required along lot lines that adjoin rural area or residential zones; and
- A conditional use permit is required, except that a special use permit would be required if helicopter fueling, maintenance or storage is proposed.

FINAL CONSIDERATION:
In addition to the proposed amendments contained in the Proposed Ordinance, Councilmembers may offer additional amendments for consideration by the Council. As a result, persons interested in any of the issues raised in the Proposed Ordinance should make their views known at the public hearing on August 17, 2021. Amendments that may be considered for adoption by the Council on August 17, 2021 or thereafter include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- Any amendment offered, or relating to topics discussed, during the review of the subject legislation in committee.
- Any matter preserved for consideration by the Council by a member during previous committee meetings.
