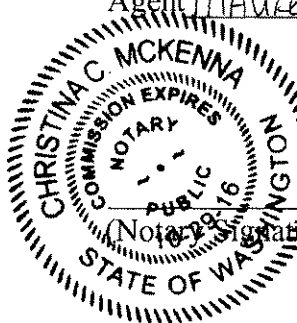

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 2nd day of December, 2013, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2013-0472, relating to zoning, adding new sections to K.C.C. chapter 21A.06.

### SUMMARY

This public hearing is to consider adoption of proposed ordinance relating to development regulations for recreational marijuana producers, processors, and retailers as authorized by the State of Washington under Initiative 502, standards for the siting of recreational marijuana businesses licensed by Washington State Liquor Control Board ordinance and would regulate where recreational marijuana businesses for production, processing and retail sales would be allowed.

Sections 1 through 6 of the ordinance adopt new definitions or amend existing definitions related to the production, processing and retail sales of marijuana. Section 7 allows marijuana retail stores no larger than 5,000 square feet in the Community Business and Regional Business zones. Section 8 allows marijuana processing in several zones; in the Agriculture and Rural Area zones, only limited processing is allowed and only as an accessory to marijuana production. In the Community Business and Regional Business zones and in the Redmond Ridge Business Park, processing at different scales and intensity is allowed depending on whether the area is inside or outside the urban growth area and the type of permitting process. Processing is allowed in the Industrial Zone limited to 30,000 square feet. Section 9 allows marijuana production (growing) in the Agriculture and Rural Area zones in existing buildings and up to 10,000 square feet outdoors and in greenhouses. In the Community Business and Regional Business zones and the Redmond Ridge Business Park indoor marijuana production is allowed with size limits based on the permitting process. Sections 10 through 12 prohibit marijuana production, processing and retailing as home occupations or as a home industry.
