1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the removal of
 2 approximately 12 acres of land from the city of Issaquah's
 3 sewer service area and annexation into the Sammamish
 4 Plateau water and sewer district, known as the NE 1st &
 5 Juniper Annexation, for the purpose of sewer service.

6 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

7 1. A notice of intention proposing the removal of approximately 12 acres
 8 of land, from the city of Issaquah's sewer service area and annexation into
 9 the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district, known as the NE 1st &
 10 Juniper Annexation, for the purpose of sewer service was filed with the
 11 county council on August 25, 2022.

12 2. The NE 1st & Juniper Annexation area is within the city of Issaquah's
 13 sewer service area.

14 3. The NE 1st & Juniper Annexation area is on the boundary of the
 15 district's and the city's sewer service boundaries.

16 4. The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district provides sewer
 17 service to a portion of the parcels in the NE 1st & Juniper Annexation
 18 area.

19 5. The city of Issaquah and the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer
 20 district entered into an interlocal agreement in 2017 to identify the district

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21 as the most logical long-term provider of sewer service to the area.

22 6. The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district filed a determination
23 of nonsignificance on the proposed transfer dated March 9, 2022.

24 7. The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district has approved the
25 proposed transfer in Resolution No. 5118, passed on July 25, 2022.

26 8. The utilities technical review committee reviewed the Sammamish
27 Plateau water and sewer district 2013 sewer comprehensive plan and
28 found that plan met the criteria for approval. The county approved the
29 most recent plan for the Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district in
30 2015, as part of Ordinance 18061.

31 9. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has
32 considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040.

33 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

34 SECTION 1. The removal of approximately 12 acres of land from the city of
35 Issaquah's sewer service area and annexation into the Sammamish Plateau water and
36 sewer district for the purpose of providing sewer service described in Attachment A to
37 this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed annexation is consistent with
38 RCW 57.02.040.

39 SECTION 2. The Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district is the appropriate
40 entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

41 SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval

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- 42 or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service
- 43 to this annexation area.

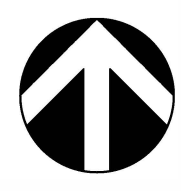
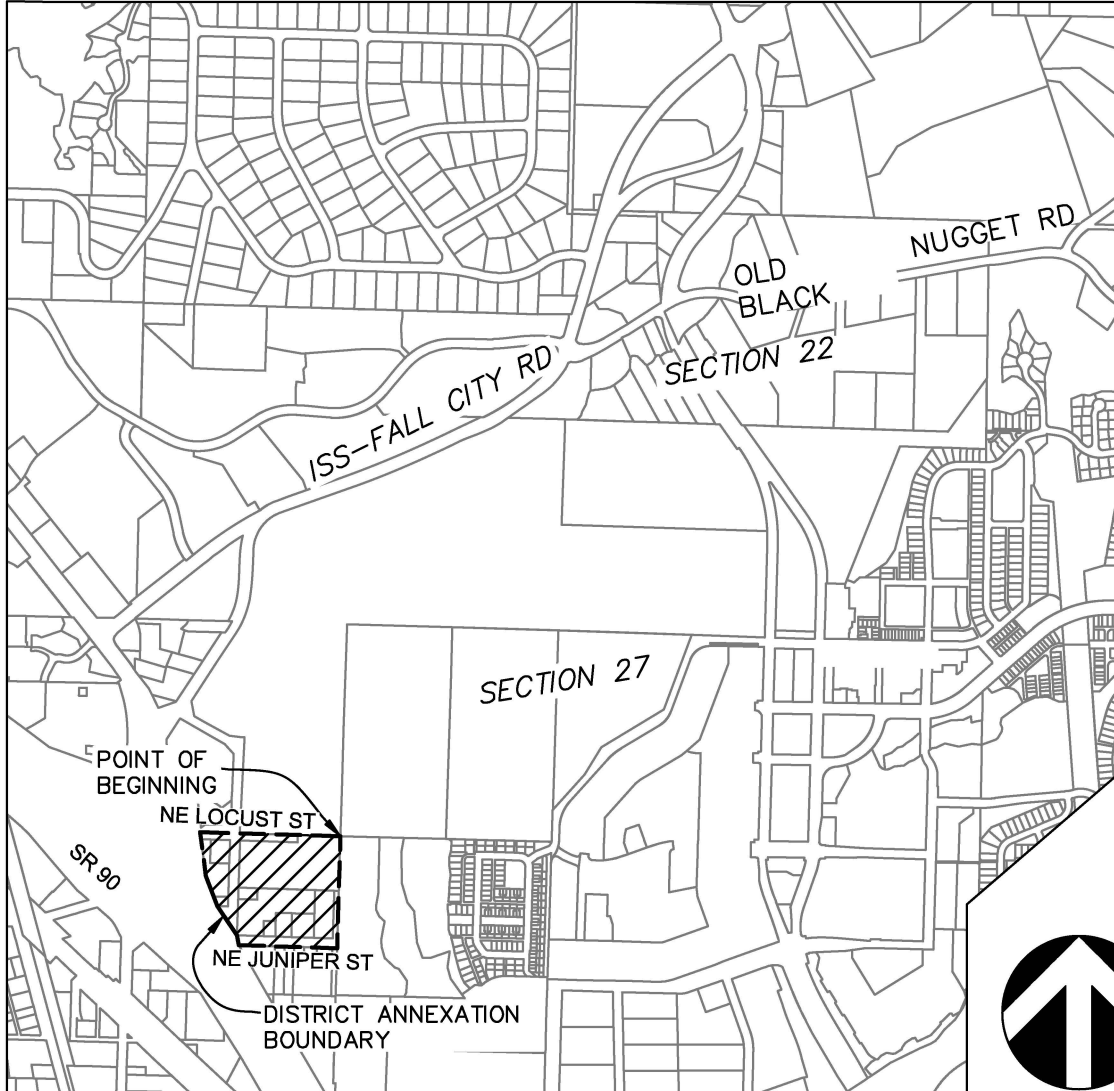


