Dear Ms. Dougherty,

A motion was passed unanimously at the December 2008 general meeting of the Vashon-Maury Island Community Council. A survey was distributed to neighbors adjoining the proposed parking areas prior to the motion's adoption, and much enthusiastic support (no negative feedback) was received:

"The Public Safety Committee of the Vashon-Maury Island Community Council request the repeal of King County ordinance #9723, which authorized parking restrictions on the following roads.

The repeal will allow for the following actions to be taken:

104th Ave SW between SW Cowen Road and SW 110th St (West side). Removal of all 3 "No Parking" (R7-1) signs.

SW 110th St between 103rd Ave SW and 104th Ave SW (South side). Removal of all 4 "No Parking" (R7-1) signs.

As King County has made significant improvements to the shoulders of these roadways, including undergrounding drainage, they no longer pose a parking hazard."

4 An ordinance relating to traffic control, prohibiting park-
5 ing at all times on the west side of 104th Avenue Southwest
6 from Southwest Cowan Road to Southwest 110th Street and on
7 the south side of Southwest 110th Avenue from 103rd Avenue
8 Southwest to 104th Avenue Southwest, and amending King
9 County Ordinance 5292, Schedule 14.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1: Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized
11 by RCW 46.90, Schedule 14 of King County Ordinance 5292 which prohibits
12 parking at all times along county roads, is amended to add the following
13 roads:

14 104TH AVENUE SOUTHWEST, on the west side from Southwest Cowan Road
15 to Southwest 110th Street.

16 SOUTHWEST 110TH STREET, on the south side from 103rd Avenue Southwest
17 to 104th Avenue Southwest.

18 SECTION 2: Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction
19 shall be installed by the proper authority.

20 SECTION 3: Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the
21 punishment shall be provided by the laws of the State of Washington.

23 November, 1990.
