* A person has a disability if the person answers yes to any of the following on the Census 2002 long form:

Does this person have any of the following long-lasting conditions:

- a. Blindness, deadness, or a severe vision or hearing impairment?
- b. Condition that substantially limits one or more basic physical activities such as walking, climbing stairs, reaching, lifting, or carrying?

Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition lasting 6 months or more, does this person have any difficulty in doing any of the following activities:

- a. Learning, remembering, or concentrating?
- b. Dressing, bathing, or getting around inside the home?
- c. (Answer if the person is 16 YEARS OLD OR OVER.) Going outside the home alone to shop or visit a doctor's office?
- d. (Answer if the person is 16 YEARS OLD OR OVER.) Working at a job or business?

NOTE: Later releases of Census Data will have the responses to each question at the block group level. This should come by October 2002.
