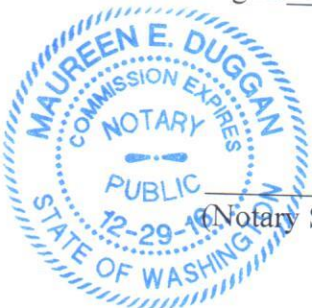

KING COUNTY HEARING EXAMINER NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Proposed Ordinance 2016-0242

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, a public hearing will be held before the King County Hearing Examiner on the 26th day of May, 2016, at 1:30pm, to consider Proposed Ordinance 2016-0242, to hear objections to the proposed assessment roll for Lake Management District No. 2, in the Lake Geneva watershed. The hearing will be held at the Federal Way Senior Center, 4016 S 352nd Street, Auburn, Washington.

The Metropolitan King County Council has adopted Ordinance 18282, which created the Lake Geneva Lake Management District No. 2, encompassing those properties adjacent to Lake Geneva. As part of Ordinance 18282, the Council designated the Hearing Examiner as the officer holding the public hearing to hear objections to the proposed special assessment roll.

The roll, posted today both physically at the hearing site and to <http://kingcounty.gov/independent/hearing-examiner/lake-geneva-management-district/Special%20Assessment%20Roll.aspx>, includes special assessments of \$14,500 collected annually for ten years, with single-family residential properties paying \$145 per year, vacant parcels \$45 per year, King County-owned park parcels \$1,785 per year, and the Washington state-owned boat launch parcel \$4,345 per year.

Objections to the proposed special assessment roll "must be in writing, include clear grounds for objections, and must be filed prior to the public hearing"; failure to do so waives the objection. RCW 36.61.140. Monday, May 23, 2016, at 4:30 p.m. is the Hearing Examiner's deadline for receiving such objections. Emailing objections to hearingexaminer@kingcounty.gov is acceptable, as is hand-delivery or mail. Note that this deadline is for receipt of the objections; for those who wish to mail, this likely means postmarking the objection by the previous Thursday (May 19). Mailed objections may be sent to Office of the Hearing Examiner, King County Courthouse, 516 Third Avenue Room 1200, Seattle, Washington 98104.

Within ten business days of the conclusion of the hearing, the Examiner will issue a recommendation to the Council and will provide interested persons with instructions on how anyone may protest our recommendation. The Council may then adopt Proposed Ordinance 2016-0242, approving, modifying, or rejecting the special assessment roll.
