1 AN ORDINANCE creating a parks citizen oversight board;  
2 and amending Ordinance 14586, Section 7.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 14586, Section 7, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 A. ~~((If the levy is approved by the voters in accordance with section 6 of this~~  
8 ~~ordinance, a county parks citizen oversight board shall be established.))~~ There is hereby  
9 created a county parks citizen oversight board.

10 B. The board shall consist of ~~((thirteen members))~~ nine voting members  
11 including at least one member residing in each of the nine council districts. Each  
12 councilmember shall nominate a representative from the councilmember's district. If the  
13 executive does not appoint a person that has been nominated by a councilmember, the  
14 executive must request that the councilmember nominate another candidate for  
15 appointment. Board members shall be confirmed by the council. Members shall be  
16 residents of King County and may not be elected or appointed officials of any unit of  
17 government.

18            C. On or before May 30 of each year beginning in the year 2005, the board shall  
19 review and report to the King County executive and the King County council on the  
20 parks and recreation division's expenditure of levy proceeds. Eleven copies of the report  
21 shall be filed with the clerk of the council, for distribution to all councilmembers.

22            D. The parks and recreation division shall provide the board with the quarterly  
23 reports that the parks and recreation division transmits to the King County council in

24 accordance with K.C.C.7.08.090.


25 E. The board expires June 30, 2008.


