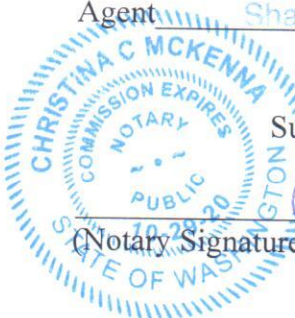

Rapp quickly establishes himself in secondary

HUSKY NOTEBOOK

Taylor Rapp's rapid ascension to stardom hasn't surprised the Huskies.

The true-freshman safety from Bellingham enrolled early at Washington in January and participated in spring drills. Coach Chris Petersen took notice of Rapp immediately.

"He broke his hand the second day, and I'm thinking, well, there goes his spring football," Petersen said. "Now, next day, I didn't even know, he's out there with a big club on it, not even thinking twice about it. That's him. He's been great."

On Tuesday, Rapp was named the Pac-12's freshman defensive player of the year, joining an illustrious UW fraternity that includes two of the program's most decorated players. He's the only Husky to earn freshman honors in a year, joining Reggie Williams (2011) and Jake Locker (2007) as the only Huskies to earn freshman honors in a year.

Rapp has played in every game and started eight times for Washington, which routinely uses five defensive backs. He is fifth on the team with 42 tackles.

Co-defensive coordinator Jimmy Lake has raved about Rapp's sure-tackling abilities and said the newcomer took his game to another level when he collected two interceptions during a 26-13 loss to USC three weeks ago.

Rapp's two picks are tied for the team lead.

"To separate yourself as a DB, you need to make the big momentum-swinging plays, and he did that," Lake said. "He's got that in him. We always talk about takeaways and turnovers. Getting the ball back."

"I can be one of those guys that you talk about for a long, long time."

Almost remarkably Rapp beat out more seasoned and veteran teammates to establish a significant role in a veteran secondary that includes All-Pac-12 first-team picks Sidney Jones and Kevin Baker, plus honorable-mention selection Bradford King.

"That's his guy that's going to be like the kids coming down the line," King said. "Mentally, he's there. Just seeing him on the field and playing with him, I wouldn't know how old he was. ... Now he's just that freshman thing behind him and he's just another player back there. He's a part of our unit. He's a part of Death Row. He's fully engaged in it."

3 on all-academic Pac-12 first-team

Washington's Ben Burris-Kirven, Jake Eldrenkamp and Jeff Lindquist were named Wednesday to the Pac-12's all-academic first team, three of the 16 players recognized for their academics by the conference.

Eldrenkamp, a senior from Medina, is the only three-time, first-team all-academic selection on the team this season. An offensive lineman who graduated cum laude with a finance degree from the Foster School of Business, he was also named Academic All-District 8 and was a first-team All-Pac-12 offensive lineman.

Lindquist is a two-time Pac-12 academic honoree, having earned a spot on the team last year. The former quarterback turned tight end from Mercer Island is also a Foster School graduate who boasts a 3.50 grade-point average.

Burris-Kirven, a sophomore from Menlo Park, Calif., is a linebacker and top special-team performer who was also a member of the All-District 8 team this year. He

carries a 3.71 GPA as a pre-arcs and sciences major.

Six Huskies were named to the second-team sophomore wide receiver Andre Baccellia (3.42 GPA, pre-arts and sciences), junior defensive lineman Greg Gaines (3.13,

pre-social sciences), sophomore defensive lineman Vita Vea (3.10, anthropology), sophomore linebacker Tevis Bartlett (3.58, pre-arts and sciences), Baker (3.09, American ethnic studies) and junior defensive back Trevor

Walker (3.31, economics). Seven Huskies earned honorable mention: quarterback Jake Browning, King, safety Joey McIntosh, tight end Landon Sample, safety Hayden Schuh, center Coleman Shelton and linebacker

Psalm Woodching.

Named Tuesday the Pac-12's offensive player of the year, Browning on Wednesday was named one of five finalists for the Walter Camp Football Foundation 2014 Player of the Year award.

Browning is joined by Louisville QB Lamar Jackson, Clemson QB Deshaun Watson, Alabama DE Jonathan Allen and Michigan linebacker return specialist Jabrill Peppers.

Also Wednesday, Browning was named one of 10 finalists for the Manning Award, to be given to the nation's top quarterback. Among the other finalists are Washington State's Luke Falk and USC's Sam Darnold.
