1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2004 levy of property
2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2005; and
3 amending Ordinance 15095, Sections 1, 2 and 3.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 15095, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 The county assessor of King County has certified to the metropolitan King
9 County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized
10 amounts to ((~~\$247,766,412,831~~) \$247,814,066,120 and as adjusted for senior citizens
11 exemptions provided for in RCW 84.36.381 and for omitted assessments in accordance
12 with RCW 84.40.080 is ((~~\$ 245,811,601,442~~) \$245,854,559,489).

13 SECTION 2. Ordinance 15095, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 The metropolitan King County council imposes the levies necessary to fund
15 estimated expenditures for the year 2005 as listed in this section. These amounts do not
16 include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including
17 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In

18 accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes
19 available to the county related to new construction, improvements to property, refunds
20 and any increase in the assessed value of state assessed property. In calculating the
21 amount of regular property tax monies needed, the council was cognizant of (~~this sum~~
22 ~~and it is~~) these sums and they are therefore included in the following levy totals.




