NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 25th day of September, 2017, at 1:30 p.m., to consider an ordinance that will enable King County to sell approximately 1.43 acres to Sound Transit for the Northgate Link Light Rail Station, part of the King County Metro Northgate Transit Center located at 10200 First Avenue Northeast, Seattle, Washington.

SUMMARY

King County is proposing this ordinance to sell property containing approximately 1.43 acres located in County Council District One at 10200 First Avenue Northeast, Seattle, WA 98125, to Sound Transit. The property is located east of First Avenue Northeast, between Northeast 103rd Street to the north and Northeast 100th Street to the south, together with a small area in the block to the north, consisting of portions of tax parcel nos. 3226049424 and 3226049002. Sound Transit intends to use the property as the location of an elevated light rail station, together with a new transit plaza and a relocated bus roadway.
