RE: Formation of Hospital District No. 5

Dear Ms. Noris:

King County Elections received a petition, dated August 24, 2005, calling for formation of Hospital District No. 5.

The legal references governing this petition are RCW 70.44.030 and RCW 70.44.020, which states:

“in the event such a petition is filed containing not less than ten percent of the voters of the proposed district who voted at the last general election.”

These legal references further state:

“When the petition is found to be sufficient the auditor shall forthwith transmit it, together with the certificate of sufficiency attached thereto, to the county legislative authority, who shall fix a date for a hearing on such petition....”

The total number of signatures needed was 708; we found 720 valid signatures.

King County Elections has found this petition for annexation to be sufficient.
