Dear Councilmember Upthegrove:

This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that would, if enacted, ratify a memorandum of agreement (MOA) between King County and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 117 (Union), representing employees in the Metro Transit Department for a contractual period of September 2, 2023 through December 31, 2024. Adoption of this proposed Ordinance will enable King County to provide bargained-for wages to employees who provide vital Metro Transit services in our community.

This MOA covers employees in a bargaining unit composed of supervisory, managerial, real estate, land use, and environmental planning job classifications in the Capital Division of the Metro Transit Department. The approximately 12 employees in these positions provide construction management and supervision in the Capital Division in support of the Metro Transit Department.

During 2023, as a result of a unique wage compression issue in Metro's Capital Division, the County and the Union (the parties) engaged in discussions to address the issue. The parties agreed to a six percent wage increase, retroactive to September 2, 2023, applied to all employees covered by this bargaining unit.

A complete breakdown of the costs associated with this agreement can be found in the accompanying fiscal note, which has been reviewed by the Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget. Supplemental budget authority is not needed for this agreement.

Thank you for your consideration of this proposed Ordinance. This important legislation will ratify the negotiated MOA which provides the competitive wages necessary to retain highly

qualified Transit Capital Unit supervisors and managers in the Capital Division of the Metro Transit Department.
