SEPA EXEMPTION DETERMINATION

Project: Mitigation Payment System Ordinance Revising King County Codes
14.75.040 and 14.75.100

CIP Number: A48785

Location: Unincorporated King County

Scope of Work: An ordinance revising the King County Mitigation Payment System (MPS) Code Sections 14.75.040 and 14.75.100. The ordinance updates the King County MPS fee schedule to reflect the termination of the reciprocal MPS Interlocal Agreement the County has with the City of Covington on October 1, 2010. The changes to the code include removal of the City of Covington projects, reflecting how the fees charged by the County are changed, setting the mitigation payment system program project list and providing for an updated road mitigation payment system fee schedule.

SEPA Exemption: As a non-project action, King County has determined that this project is categorically exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) under WAC 197-11- 800(14)(h) that provides:

(14) Activities of agencies. The following administrative, fiscal and personnel activities of agencies shall be exempt: (h) All agency organization, reorganization, internal operational planning or coordination of plans or functions.
