Surplusing the Kent/James Park and Ride Lot Grant No. WA-03-0016

Dear Mr. Tordillos:

This responds to your request for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) concurrence with the surplus of 629 stalls at the Kent/James Street Park and Ride. Through a series of correspondence, the County has provided all information needed by FTA in support of its request.

FTA's rules regarding the disposition of excess real property are contained in Circular 5010.1C, Chapter II, paragraph 2.c. Please keep in mind the following:

- Sales procedures shall be followed that provide for open competition to the greatest extent
 practicable and result in the highest possible return or at least payment of appraised fair market
 value.
- The County shall not dispose of the stalls until the replacement facility (Sound Transit Commuter Rail garage) is fully operational, bus service can be redirected to the garage, and the agreement with Sound Transit has been executed.
- Record the receipt of the proceeds in your accounting system, showing that the funds are restricted for use in a subsequent FTA eligible capital project. The subsequent capital grant application should document that the gross project cost has been reduced with proceeds from the earlier transaction. When you receive payment for this property, please provide FTA with a receipt or journal entry showing that the use of these funds has been restricted to another FTA eligible capital project. This accounting record should be readily available for FTA review.
