AN ORDINANCE dissolving King County Road  
Improvement District No. 108.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Kent by City Ordinance 3171, effective July  
1, 1994, has annexed an area encompassing King County  
Road Improvement District No. 108.

Road Improvement District No. 108 was created by King  
County Ordinance 8332 for the purpose of maintaining  
and providing energy for street lights within the plat  
of Tudor Square Divisions 1, 2 and 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby dissolved, King County Road  
Improvement District No. 108 and the street light maintenance  
assessment roll established to assess properties within the plat  
of Tudor Square Divisions 1, 2 and 3.
