On June 22, 2010, the City of Covington's City Council adopted Ordinance No. 08-10 replacing Chapter 12.105 of the Covington Municipal Code relating to the calculation and collection of transportation impact fees.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Interlocal Agreement executed on September 17, 2002 and entered into between the City and King County to create a cross-jurisdictional transportation mitigation payment system, this letter shall serve as our 60 day written notice that the City of Covington is terminating said Agreement effective October 1, 2010. As instructed by the Agreement, upon effective termination, any fees previously collected but not yet transferred, or any refunds due, shall be transferred in accordance with the Agreement.
