In accordance with the Washington State Growth Management Act, King County hereby notifies the Department of Commerce of its intent to amend the King County Code relating to the Transportation Concurrency Management Program.

The King County Executive is proposing an ordinance to amend King County's Transportation Concurrency Management Program (enacted by King County Code 14.70) by adopting a 2010 Transportation Concurrency map update. We are providing you with an electronic copy of the proposed ordinance for review.

The King County Executive will transmit this proposed ordinance to the King County Council in October 2010. I anticipate the proposed ordinance will be acted upon by the King County Council in the fall of 2010.
