6	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
7	1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of South
8	336th Street hereinafter described.
9	2. The department of transportation notified the various utilities
10	companies serving the area and has been advised that easements were not
11	required within the vacation area.
12	3. The subject right-of-way was dedicated in the Plat of Maltby's Lake
13	Geneva Five Acre Tracts, Volume 14 of Plats, Page 73, Records of King
14	County, Washington.
15	4. The department of transportation road maintenance records indicate
16	that King County has not maintained South 336th Street. The records
17	indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition.

18	5. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the
19	right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the
20	public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax
21	rolls.
22	6. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with
23	K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty
24	percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way which was
25	determined from records of the department of assessments. King County
26	is in receipt of \$8,468.36 from the petitioner.
27	Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was
28	held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 12th day of December,
29	2001.
30	In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation,
31	the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of
32	King County to grant said petition.
33	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
34	SECTION 1. The council, on the 14th day of January, 2002, hereby vacates and
35	abandons that portion of South 336th Street as dedicated in the Plat of Maltby's Lake
36	Geneva Five Acre Tracts, Volume 14 of Plats, Page 73, Records of King County,
37	Washington, described as follows:
38	Being that portion of said South 336th Street, lying Northerly of Tracts 2 and 5 of said
39	plat and Northerly of that portion of Old Military Road vacated on September 28, 1936,
40	running along the east line of Tracts 2 and 4 of said plat and lying 50 feet Westerly of the

- centerline of Military Road South (Military Road South Section, No. 1375 Surv. No. 108
- 42 ¾, EST. 3-4-29, C.C. Vol. 29-385).
- 43 EXCEPTING THE West 150 feet of said Tract 5 thereof
- 44 Containing 17,247 square feet more or less.

DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:

The Department of Transportation's written report to the King County Hearing Examiner for Item No. V-2421 was received by the Examiner on November 20, 2001.

PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department of Transportation's Report and examining available information



on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject as follows:

The hearing on Item No. V-2409 was opened by the Examiner at 10:00 a.m., December 6, 2001, in the Fifth Floor Conference Room of the Union Bank of California Building, $900 - 4^{th}$ Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104, and closed at 10:15 a.m. Participants at the public hearing and the exhibits offered and entered are listed in the attached minutes. NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$125.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) on or before December 24, 2001. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on or before December 31, 2001.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.
